# **Introduction and History**

"A.K.G Memorial Co-operative College of Nursing", a unit of Kannur Co-operative Hospital Society Ltd.No.C-834 ,was envisioned and established in August 2008 as a memorial of Com. A.K.Gopalan (AKG).

Sri. A.K Gopalan was a renounced politician, a fabulous orator and a great Parliamentarian in the Indian history and a person who toiled throughout his life for the upliftment of poor and downtrodden.

AKGMCCON is functioning at Mavilayi- the native place of Sri. AKG, more over a salubrious hilly area 10km west of Kannur town, away from the buzz and pollution of Kannur City.

Adequate infrastructure facilities as per the norms of statutory bodies viz, INC, KNMC & KUHS and the use of modern educational technologies in the teaching - learning process is the salient feature of our institution.

Our vision is to mould a new generation with the skill, knowledge and attitude to provide comprehensive nursing care to the sick and the disabled and to bring about new innovations in the field of Nursing through quality education, practice and research.

A.K.G Memorial Co-operative College of Nursing offers Basic B.Sc. Nursing degree programme since 2008 and is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. 50% of the total seats will be filled up by the Govt. in accordance with the merit and reservation principles, 35% of the total seats (Management quota) will be filled up from the list of the candidates who are eligible as per the prospectus and application forms received against the notification by the Management directly in accordance with the merit in qualifying examination and the management shall also be entitled to fill up the remaining 15% seats from the list of eligible candidates who are the children /dependents of Non residential Indians. (NRI)

This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the management quota seats for the year 2020-2021 and is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the management and subject to the Govt. orders.

# Aim

# The aim of the undergraduate nursing programme is to:

- ▶ Prepare graduates to assume responsibilities as competent professional nurses and midwives in providing promotive, preventive, curative, and rehabilitative services.
- Prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations, protect the rights and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice. They are also expected to assume various roles as Nurse educator, supervisor, manager etc in a clinical/public health setting/school of Nursing.

# **Objectives**

On completion of the four year B.Sc. Nursing programme the graduates will be able to:

- 1. Apply knowledge from physical, biological, and behavioral sciences, medicine including alternative systems and nursing in providing holistic/comprehensive nursing care to individuals, families and communities.
- 2. Demonstrate understanding of life style and other factors, which affect health of individuals and group.
- Provide nursing care based on steps of nursing process in collaboration with the health team members.
- 4. Demonstrate critical thinking skill in making decisions in all situations in order to provide quality care.
- 5. Utilize the latest trends and technology in providing health care.
- 6. Provide promotive, preventive and restorative health services in line with the National health policies and programmes.
- 7. Practice within the framework of code of ethics and professional conduct, and acceptable standards of practice within the legal boundaries.
- 8. Communicate effectively with individuals, groups and members of the health team in order to promote effective interpersonal relationship and teamwork.
- 9. Demonstrate skills in teaching to individuals and groups in clinical/Community Health settings.
- 10. Participate effectively as members of the health team in health care delivery system.
- 11. Demonstrate leadership and managerial skills in clinical/community health settings.
- 12. Conduct/participate need based research studies to improve the quality of nursing care.

**Govt / General merit seats:**- GM seats are those seats set apart for the students allotted by the Govt. following the guidelines of INC, KNMC and University.

**Management seats:** Management seats are those seats set apart for the eligible candidates selected from the applications received against the notification by the management directly based on the merit in qualifying exam and interview.

**NRI**:- NRI seats are those seats set apart for the Son/Daughter, Brother/Sister, Niece /Nephew, first cousin or dependant of nonresident Indian citizen or in their absence, foreign citizen of Kerala origin or their absence NRI's who are non-Keralites.

NRI candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Nursing course should enclose a copy of one of the following documents to prove the NRI status of his/her parent and declaration of the NRI in the prescribed form to establish his/her relationship with the candidates.

- Attested copy of the relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa details
- Attested copy of the employment certificate and relevant pages of the certificate
- ▶ Certificate issued by the Scheduled Bank stating that he/she is nonresident Indian holding a NRI account other than a Zero balance account

#### **General Information**

- ▶ University Examination shall be conducted ordinarily twice in a year (one regular and one supplementary examination every year).
- Internal assessment through sessional exams, Seminars, Assignments, Projects, Clinical evaluation, Internal practical examination etc.
- Candidates who have undergone the prescribed course of study for a period of not less than 10months of the academic year only can appear for the examination. A candidate who is absent for a total of more than 60 days continuously by interrupted within a period of 3 months during an academic year shall not be eligible to continue the course with the same batch of students.
- ▶ 50% marks for the internal assessment is mandatory for appearing the University examination.
- ▶ Candidates must secure 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject in order to appear for the University examination.
- ▶ 100% attendance in clinical practice must be acquired before the award of the degree as per Indian Nursing Council / University guidelines.
- ▶ Medium of instruction is in English. Students are expected to have proficiency in English language, verbal as well as written.

# II Eligibility for admission

#### 1. Academic

- a. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or equivalent examination recognized thereto by KUHS, Thrissur with 50% marks in physics, chemistry, biology and English put together are eligible for admission.
- b. Eligibility certificate: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health and Allied Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview.

#### 2. Age

- Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> December of that year. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
- 2. Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely S.S.L.C / ICSE/ CBSE certificate showing date of birth/ copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

# III How to apply

All candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Nursing, under Management Quota have to apply online through the website <a href="www.akgnursingcollege.com">www.akgnursingcollege.com</a> from 01.08.2020 onwards. Last date for submitting online application is 30.08.2020 before 5pm. Candidates

should register only one application for admission to BSc Nursing. <u>During the submission of online application</u>, candidates have to enter the marks obtained by them in the subjects concerned in their Qualifying Examination, through the website.

## IV Selection and Admission

- 1. Selection of the candidates for management seats will be done among the candidates who have applied through the college, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- 2. The Selected candidates will be informed of the date and time of admission
- 3. The Students shall pay the fees of the first year of the course at the time of admission.
- 4. The candidates are expected to produce the following documents in original at the time of admission
- (a) S.S.L.C. mark list
- (b) Plus two mark list
- (c) 4 Passport size photograph
- (d) Transfer certificate
- (e) Course and Conduct Certificate issued by the head of educational institution last attended
- (f) Hepatitis B vaccination certificate
- 5. The fact that candidates have been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection.
- 6. The Institute will not be responsible for the non receipt of applications, interview memos and other correspondence regarding admission.

7. If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.

# VII. DEALING WITH FRAUDULENT INFORMATION

Admission to the Courses is purely provisional and if any fraud is detected at any stage in the mark list or certificate produced by the candidate, his/her admission will automatically be cancelled and he/she be removed from the rolls and appropriate legal procedure will be initiated by the Institution against such candidates.

# VIII. Special instruction

# (a) Ragging

According to the Kerala Prohibition of "Ragging Act 1998", ragging means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or emberrassment to the student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which, such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do."

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in this college. All the members of the college are committed to abolish ragging in their campus. Hence any student who indulge in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as preview of law. In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the institution

- (b) Use of mobile phone
